In 2013, the Bureau of Labor Statistics reported more than 23,000 significant injuries caused by assaults at work, with more than 70% of these assaults in healthcare and social service settings. Healthcare and social service workers are almost four times as likely to be injured as a result of violence than the average private-sector worker.
